General Description

The purpose of this job is to respond to emergency calls to provide efficient and immediate care to the critically ill and injured, and to transport the patient to a medical facility.

This class works under general supervision, independently developing work methods and sequences.

Duties and Responsibilities

The functions listed below are those that represent the majority of the time spent working in this position. Management may assign additional functions related to the type of work of the position as necessary.

- Drive the emergency response vehicle.
- Initiate patient care.
- Assist with the proper extrication of trapped patients.
- Direct the operations of the first responders and bystanders.
- Manage control drugs on ambulance.
- Ensures that all documents are complete after each call.
- Ensure proper radio communications with dispatch, hospital and other units.
- Operates emergency vehicles.
- Decides on patient transport destination.
- Drives the ambulance in emergency situations.
- Assists with public relations events such as Blood Pressure checks, safety programs, Career Day, and EMS week.
- Provide professional and courteous customer service at all times to in-house staff and general public either by telephone, electronically, or face to face.
- Check ambulance supplies and condition, and resupply at the beginning of the shift and after every call.
- Performs other duties and related work as instructed and assigned

Minimum Education and Experience Requirements:

Requires High School graduation or GED equivalent. No prior experience is required.

Physical Demands:

Performs medium to heavy work that involves walking, standing, stooping, lifting, digging, pushing and raising objects and also involves exerting between 20 to 50 pounds of force on a regular and recurring basis and 50 to 100 pounds of force on an occasional basis. Must be able to lift 125 pounds.
