General Description

The purpose of this job is to ensure that all parks in the County are kept clean of litter, properly mowed and all structures and equipment are safe and functional.

This class works under close supervision according to set procedures.

Duties and Responsibilities

The functions listed below are those that represent the majority of the time spent working in this position. Management may assign additional functions related to the type of work of the position as necessary.

- Open and close county parks.
- Operate lawn mowers, weed eaters, trimmers.
- Check county parks for needed maintenance.
- Check restrooms for discrepancies replenish products.
- Remove all litter from county parks.
- Ensure waterfronts, piers, boardwalks, and boat landings are clear of debris.
- Performs other duties and related work as instructed and assigned.

Minimum Education and Experience Requirements:

Requires High School graduation or GED equivalent. No prior experience is required.

Physical Demands:

Performs medium to heavy work that involves walking, standing, stooping, lifting, digging, pushing and raising objects and also involves exerting between 20 to 50 pounds of force on a regular and recurring basis and 50 to 100 pounds of force on an occasional basis.

Unavoidable Hazards (Work Environment):

- Involves routine and frequent exposure to:
 - Bright/dim light; Dusts and pollen.
 - Extreme heat and/or cold; Wet or humid conditions.
 - Extreme noise levels, Animals/wildlife.
 - Vibration; Fumes and/or noxious odors.
 - Traffic; Moving machinery.
 - Electrical shock; Heights.
