**1. ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION**

Chairman Wimberly recognized County Administrator Harold Young. Administrator Young asked how the option one (1) ordinance would affect legitimate clubs or businesses. Deputy County Attorney Lakesha Jefferies responded that the ordinance utilizes the definition of commercial establishment.

Attorney Jefferies advised that one of the options makes it an offense for just the owner/operator to operate the business between the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am. The

other option makes it an offense against the owner/operator and against anyone who is consuming alcohol on the premises.

Chairman Wimberly recognized Councilman Ravenell. Councilman Ravenell asked where the ordinance would apply within the County. Attorney Jefferies responded that the ordinance applies to unincorporated Orangeburg County.

After further discussion, the Committee agreed to remove section two-b (2B) from the existing draft and to change the language of section one-c (1C). The Committee further agreed to meet again prior to the regularly schedule session of County Council on September 21, 2015 so the ordinance could be considered at that meeting.

Acting Committee Chairman Wimberly motioned that section two-b (2B) be removed and the discussed changes be adopted to section one-c (1C). Councilwoman Cooper-Smith seconded the motion. Motion carried. (2-0-0-1).


#### 5. VOTE FOR ADJOURNMENT
