**On the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May 2018, Chairman Wright called to order a regular session meeting of the Orangeburg County Council at 5:38 p.m.**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**Chairman Wright asked for a motion on the minutes of the Orangeburg County Council on the above dates be approved as written. Vice-Chairwoman Janie Cooper-Smith made the motion. Councilman Johnny Ravenell seconded the motion. Motion carried. (7-0-0).**

**OTHER MATTERS**

**William Green came before Council representing Staley Street, Wilkinson Street, and Logan Street which his mother is the street captain but was not able to make it to the Council meeting. Mr. Green express the communities concern for new neighbors that have moved into the house on the corner of Wilkinson and Staley Street they have brought in farm animals and that is not allowed in their neighborhood. They have chickens but it's mainly the rooster that crows all day and all night. There are a lot of elderly people in the**

neighborhood that are on medications and are in and out of the hospital. This is not fair to our neighborhood. They have spoken to Animal Control and they stated there was nothing they could do because the neighbors could claim the animals as their pets but he expressed it should be something under the noise ordinance about this.

Administrator Young advised he would check into the matter.

Chairman Wright advised Mr. Green to leave his contact information with the County Administrator.

Chairman Wright closed public comments of other matters at 5:45 p.m. and went into the regular agenda.

### **1. PRESENTATION FROM ORANGEBURG COUNTY LITTER CONTROL**

Chairman Wright recognized Vice-Chairwoman Janie Cooper-Smith and Marie Cauty Director of the Orangeburg County Litter Control. Vice-Chairwoman Janie Cooper-Smith gave Council a detail report of the individuals who received certificates for participating in the County Wide Clean Up.

Chairman Wright thanked Vice-Chairwoman Cooper-Smith for all of her efforts in recognizing those individuals who have done an outstanding job in trying to make a difference in our County when it comes to litter and we hope people will get a sense of pride in order to keep improving on litter control.

### **2. PRESENTATION BY DR. WILLIAM (BILL) MOLNAR, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF LOWER SAVANNAH COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENT (LSCOG)**

Chairman Wright recognized Dr. William Molnar. Dr. Molnar gave Council an in depth 2017-2018 review on what the Lower Savannah Council of Governments had done in Orangeburg County.

### **3. ORDINANCE THIRD READING AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Chairman Wright read the ordinance in its entirety.

Chairman Wright open the floor for public hearing questions. There were none.

Chairman Wright yielded to Administrator Young to give a brief summary. Administrator Young advised this is a part of the State incentive that allows businesses to be located in a multi county industrial park. This particular one is kind of rare because most of the industries are located in the County but this particular one is located in the City limits so it requires a special industrial park designation for this particular business.

**Chairman Wright entertained a motion to pass the ordinance for third and final reading. Councilman Willie Owens made the motion. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chairwoman Janie Cooper-Smith made the motion. Motion carried. (7-0-0).**

#### **4. ORDINANCE THIRD READING AND PUBLIC HEARING**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE STRUCTURED PROCESS FOR THE PERMITTING OF OUTDOOR SPECIAL EVENTS IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF THE COUNTY.**

**Chairman Wright read the ordinance in its entirety.**

**Chairman Wright yielded to Administrator Young to give a brief summary. Administrator Young advised with the success and growth of Orangeburg County the County is starting to see more large events come to the County. This ordinance gives the County the ability to know before hand when an event comes the County is able to have the proper law enforcement, emergency services, also including some SCDOT in place prior to these events happening so it will not be a burden on the existing residence and be safe for people that are coming outside of the County. This ordinance is basically outlines what the event owners and managers are supposed to do prior to having an event of more than two thousand (2,000) people that are not a traditional event in Orangeburg County like Railroad Days and the Orangeburg Fair.**

**Chairman Wright open the floor for public hearing questions. There were none.**

**Chairman Wright yielded to Administrator Young to give a brief summary. Administrator Young advised this is an additional multi county jurisdiction industrial park application. This is Zeus Industrial Products, Inc. the County is allowed under the State Law of multi county jurisdiction park and this agreement will be done with Dorchester County.**

**Chairman Wright entertained a motion to pass the ordinance for third and final reading. Councilman Willie Owens made the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Heyward Livingston made the motion. Motion carried. (7-0-0).**

**Chairman Wright yielded to Administrator Young to give a summary. Administrator Young advised the submission from the planning commission met on March 14, 2018 to discuss the request from Brenda and Dennis Edmunds to rezone the property at 2972 Slab Landing Rd, Council District three (3), from Forest and Agricultural to Rural Community. The owners bought and renovated the house to run a boarding home and the zoning does not currently allow for that. The next door neighbors came to the meeting to speak against the request, citing safety concerns and an incident that has already occurred with one of the residents coming onto their property. The planning commission voted 3-2 to recommend approval of the request. It should be noted that similar uses such as substance abuse facility and adult and child day care service are already permitted in this district.**

**Chairman Wright asked, the Council if they had any questions? There were none.**

**Chairman Wright entertained a motion to pass the ordinance for third reading. Councilman Harry Wimberly made the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Willie Owens. Motion carried. (7-0-0).**

Council District 6, from residential single family to rural community. The owner wants to put a mobile home at this location. The area is predominately mobile home already. Staff recognizes this as an area that should be rezoned in the zoning ordinance update. There was no opposition to the request and the commission voted unanimously to approve and recommend to you as Council.**

The property had been a convenience store in the past and the current owner wishes to open a laundry mat which is not permitted in the FA district therefore it needed zoning approval. There was no opposition to the request and the commission voted unanimously to recommend approval.

**a. FY18-0411 INMATE TELEPHONE SERVICES FOR ORANGEBURG COUNTY DETENTION CENTER**

Chairman Wright yielded to Administrator Young to give a brief summary. Administrator Young advised FY18-0411 for Orangeburg County Detention Center Inmate Telephone Provider, the County has a current telephone provider that has been in service for approximately two (2) years but the exact date when the new facility is completed will determine when the new agreement will began. The County received seven (7) responsive proposals. Each vendors presented proposals for costs per 1st minute, add' 1 Min. Rate, 15 minute charge, and % of gross revenue offered, however the County is recommending GTL Services. GTL Services is the current vendor for the State of SC Dept. of Corrections. This vendor will provide the tablets, support and repair of equipment within one (1) hour time of service.

Chairman Wright entertained a motion to approve the recommendation for item (a) FY18-0411 under procurement. Councilman Harry Wimberly made the motion. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chairwoman Janie Cooper-Smith. Motion carried. (7-0-0).

**b. FY18-0424 ORANGEBURG COUNTY NEW DETENTION CENTER "KITCHEN EQUIPMENT"**

Chairman Wright yielded to Administrator Young to give a brief summary. Administrator Young advised FY18-0424 this is for the Orangeburg County Detention Center Kitchen Equipment it is recommended to Council for your approval Norvell Fixture & Equipment Co. from Grovetown, GA their price is \$137,900.00 for the kitchen equipment this is projected to be \$162,000 less than in the overall projected budget of \$300,000.00.

Chairman Wright entertained a motion to approve the recommendation for item (a) FY18-0424 under procurement. Councilman Heyward Livingston made the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Willie Owens. Motion carried. (7-0-0).



**c. REPLACEMENT OF EMERGENCY MOBILE COMMAND UNIT**

Chairman Wright yielded to Administrator Young to give a brief summary. Administrator Young advised the current Mobile Command Post is approaching thirty (30) years old it has been experiencing major mechanical issues and is in need of major mechanical upgrades. The mobile command unit is very vital in the day to day operations of the County for long deployments and critical situations like the one at Don's car crushing. Which the County was not about to use it at that particular event. The cost of the vehicle is \$89,900.00, however the County is seeking a grant from USDA in the amount of \$50,000.00, therefore the net cost to the County will be \$39,900.00. Which these funds are already covered in the bond funds that were done for Emergency Services equipment.

Chairman Wright entertained a motion to approve the recommendation for the Replacement of Emergency Mobile Command Unit under procurement. Councilwoman Ray Sabalis made the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Willie Owens. Motion carried. (7-0-0).

Administrator Young asked Council for a motion to sale the old Mobile Command Post to other smaller Counties.

Chairman Wright entertained a motion to approve the sale of the Orangeburg County Old Mobile Command Post to another smaller County. Councilman Willie Owens made the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Heyward Livingston. Motion carried. (7-0-0).

Chairman Wright yielded to Vice-Chairwoman Janie Cooper-Smith for any comments about the appointees from her district.

Vice-Chairwoman Janie Cooper-Smith advised she would like for Council to accept her appointee Ms. Mary L. Smalls, she is a retired librarian from South Carolina State University and she has worked of her work life as a librarian so is familiar.

Chairman Wright entertained a motion to approve the appointment. Vice-Chairwoman Janie Cooper-Smith made the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Johnny Ravenell made the motion. Motion carried. (7-0-0).

Councilman Willie Owens advised he had an appointee to the Library Board. Councilman Owens recommend to Council to appoint Arminta P. Owens to the Library Board of Trustees Board.

Chairman Wright entertained a motion to approve the appointment. Councilman Willie Owens made the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Heyward Livingston made the motion. Motion carried. (7-0-0).

**Councilman Harry Wimberly appointed the new treasurer E. Madison "Matt" Stokes to the Lower Savannah Council Government Loan Committee because they were looking for someone who had been in the banking business and Matt Stokes has agreed to serve on this committee.**

**Chairman Wright entertained a motion to appoint Matt Stokes to the Lower Savannah Council Government Loan Committee. Councilman Harry Wimberly made the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Johnny Ravenell made the motion. Motion carried. (7-0-0).**

**19. UPDATE FROM PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE**

**Chairman Wright yielded to the Public Works Committee chairperson Councilman Johnny Ravenell to give an update. Councilman Johnny Ravenell advised that the Public Works Committee had a lengthy discussions about the irrigation systems in Orangeburg County that are going across County roads. The recommendation coming from the Public Works Committee is to add to the existing ordinance to start regulates on the end guns from the irrigation systems. The end guns from the irrigation system shoots a lot of water on the County roads. When this is put in place irrigation systems will not be allowed to shoot water across Orangeburg County roads.**

**Chairman Wright ask for a motion to accept the recommendation from the Public Works Committee. Councilman Johnny Ravenell made the motion. Councilman Harry Wimberly second the motion. Motion carried. (7-0-0).**


