Addendum No. 1 (herein referred to as "Addendum")

The addendum is as follows: Questions/Responses – June 6, 2014

Questions: I saw the RFP for printing of your assessment notices, do you know what you paid per notice last time you sent them out? Also are you allowed to mail multiple notices in mailing to the same owner? What I mean is that if a person owns 10 pieces of property can you mail him all ten of his notices in one envelope or does he have to have 10 notices mailed separately to them?

Responses: I do not remember what it cost last time. Yes, we can send multiple notices to one owner in the same envelope. If there is too many for a particular owner to fit in a #10 envelope, they can be put in a 9x12 as long as the other envelope standards are followed.
